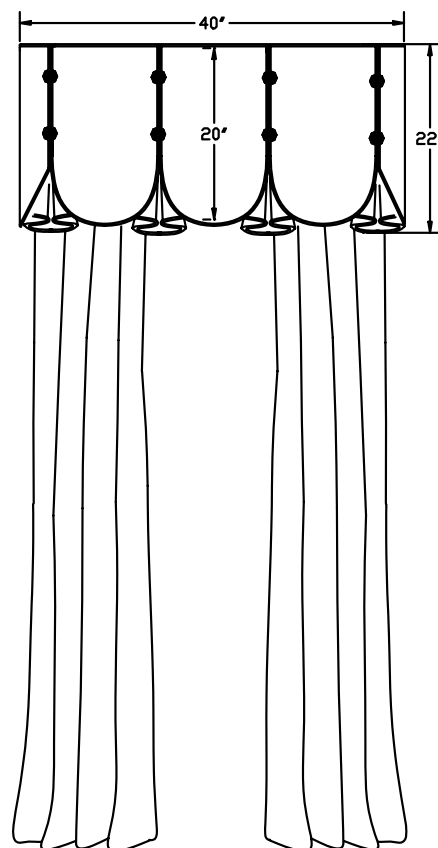




ELEANOR VALANCE WITH PANELS

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- This tailored valance with gussets can be adapted to fit any size window. Our instructions are for a valance that is 40" finished width. The information needed to add or reduce the width is included. The finished length of the valance is approximately 20" at the swags and 22" at the gussets.
- We have included instructions for making stationary side panels that consist of one width of fabric on each side. They are non-workable and each side panel covers about 12-18" of space. The length of the panels can be adapted to any length.
- This valance and panels work best when constructed out of a medium-weight decorative fabric.
- The gussets are lined in a contrast fabric. The side jabots are self-lined in the same fabric as the face fabric. The swag sections are lined in regular ivory or white drapery lining. A small decorative piping is applied to the gussets, swags, jabots and across the top of the dust board.
- Use a drapery interlining to give the valance the best body and shape. Interlining is a flannel-like cotton fabric that hangs between the face fabric and the lining. It is available in white or natural and can be found at most decorative fabric stores or at www.patemeadows.com. It is **not** the same thing as interfacing.
- This valance is mounted on a dust board. Either a 1 x 4 or 1 x 6 can be used depending on the projection desired. A 1 x 6 is suggested when installing the valance over side panels. The side panels are mounted on small sash rods 18" wide.



Fabric Requirements for Valance Only (see below for panel fabric)

**These amounts are based on 54" wide fabric. Allow extra fabric to match patterns.*

***For multiple valances, a total of 1 ½ - 2 yards for piping & buttons should be sufficient.*

Supplies:

- Temporary fabric marker
- 1 x 4 or 1 x 6 dust board cut 40" long
- 8 cover-your-own buttons 1-1/2" diameter
- 2 – 2-1/2" angle irons
- Staple gun
- 11 yards of cotton piping - 4/32"

Fabric & Supplies for Panels Only: *These amounts are for one pair of panels up to 100" long. These amounts are based on 54" wide fabric. Add extra fabric for matching of patterns.*

- 6 yards of face fabric
- 6 yards of interlining
- 6 yards of lining (ivory or white)
- 2 – 18-27" sash rods
