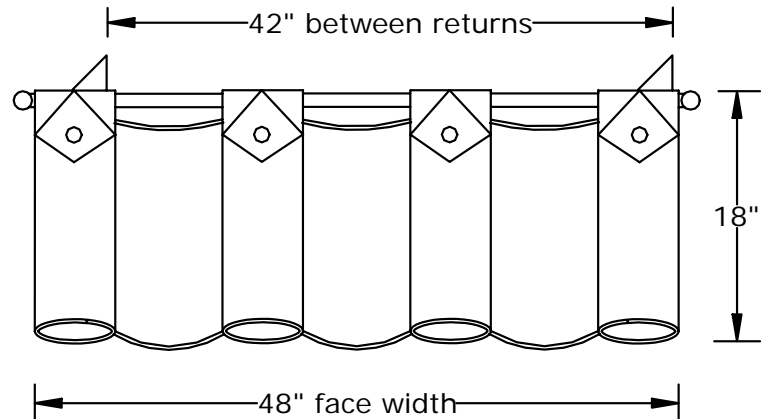




JULIA VALANCE

- This tailored, yet fun pleated valance with tabs can be adapted to fit any size window by adding additional swag sections. Our pattern, as is, makes a valance that is 46-48" finished width. Note that the returns are set in 3" from the face width of the valance. The information needed to add to or reduce the width is included. The finished length of the valance is approximately 18".



- This valance works best when constructed out of a medium-weight decorative fabric. The pleated tab sections are lined in a contrasting fabric and the swag sections are lined with regular drapery lining; however, piping must be used to prevent the lining from showing at the bottom of the treatment.
- Use a drapery interlining to give the valance the best body and shape. Interlining is a flannel-like cotton fabric that hangs between the face fabric and the lining. It is available in white and natural colors and can be found at most decorative fabric stores and at www.patemeadows.com. It is *not* the same thing as interfacing.
- We mounted our valance on an iron rod approximately 3/4" to 1" in diameter. A larger diameter rod may be used; however, the tabs will have to be adjusted.

MATERIALS

These amounts are for a valance measuring 46-48" finished, installed width (bracket to bracket measurement). See chart for other widths. **These amounts are based on 54" wide fabric.**

Fabrics:

- 2 1/4 yards of decorative fabric for valance front*
- 2 1/4 yards of drapery interlining (www.patemeadows.com)
- 3/4 yards of lining
- 1 1/2 yards of contrasting fabric for pleated tabs.
- 1 1/2 yards of contrasting fabric for piping.

Supplies:

- Temporary fabric marker
- 4 yards of 4/32"-diameter cotton piping
- 4 cover-your-own buttons 1" diameter
- Glue gun
- Double-sided tape (optional)

*Allow extra fabric for matching of patterned fabric

**For multiple valances, a total of 2 yards fabric for piping is usually sufficient.
