

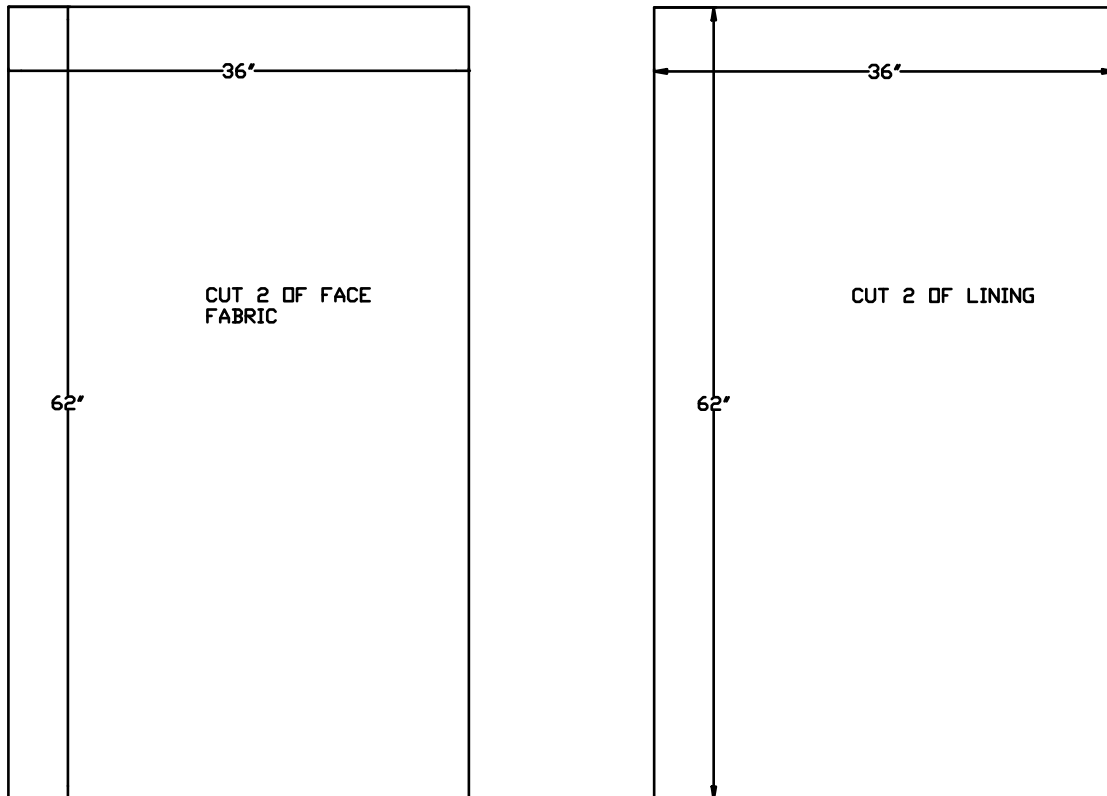
SCALLOPED TABLE SKIRT By Pate-Meadows Designs (Makes a 61" square table skirt)

Step 1: Download and print the [PDF pattern](#).

Step 2: Tape the pieces of pattern together as shown in Figure 1 on the pattern template

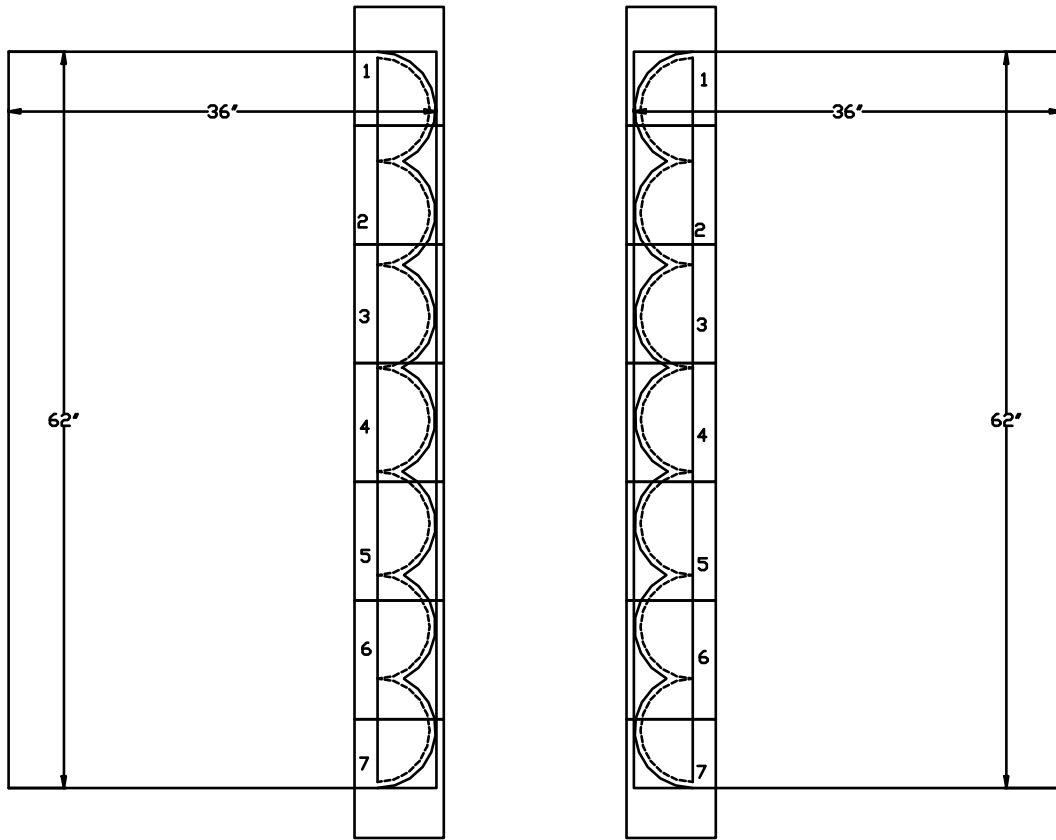
Step 3: Out of the face fabric, cut 2 pieces of fabric 36" x 62".

Step 4: Out of lining fabric, cut 2 pieces of fabric 36" x 62".

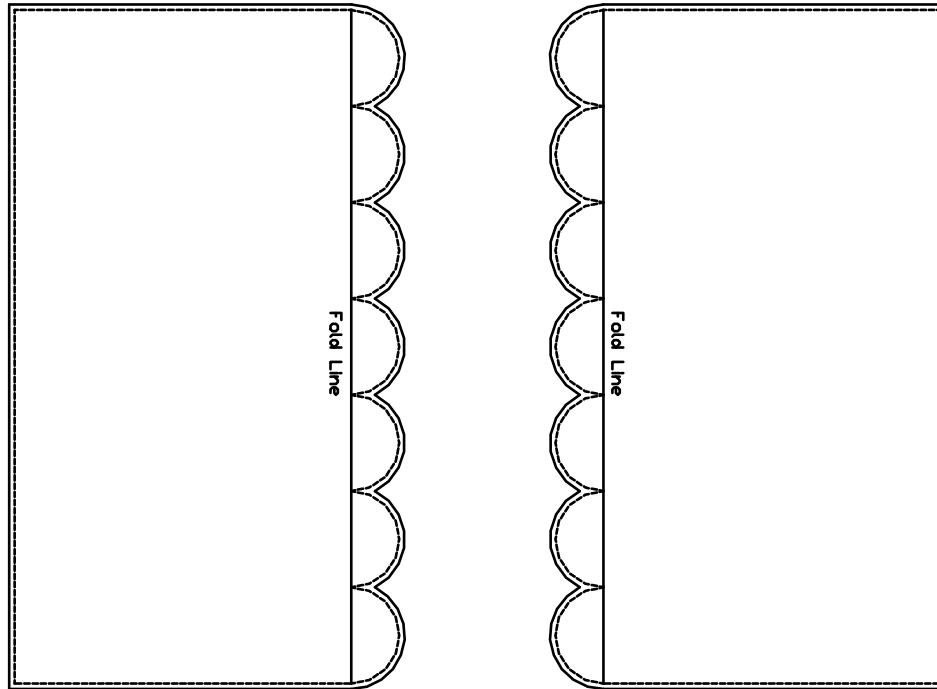


Step 5: With right sides together, lay the face fabric on top of the lining fabric and pin layers together

Step 6: Pin the taped-together pattern template on top of the layers aligning one long edge and cut out the shape. You will need to make sure you cut opposites.



Step 7: Using 1/2" seam allowance, stitch around entire piece making sure to leave a small opening for turning right side out. Clip and trim along the curved seams.



Step 8: Turn right side out and press. Make sure to read the care instructions if you are using outdoor fabric as sometimes it cannot take the high temperature of ironing.

Step 9: Press the scallops back along the fold line and use our [tack gun](#) to join the two sides together. Make sure to leave an opening for the umbrella pole (if applicable).
