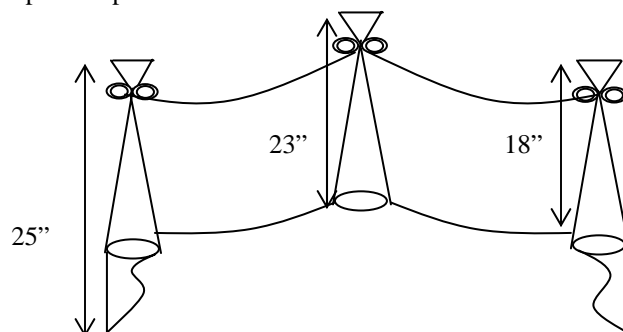


Carriage Valance

GENERAL NOTES

- This valance can be adapted to fit any window width up to 98" wide by adjusting the width of the pattern piece A (swag). The finished length of the valance is approximately 23" at the middle (top of cone to bottom of center bell), 18" at the shortest point of side jabots and 25" at the longest point of side jabots. It is pulled up in the middle 7".



- The valance works best when made from a medium-weight decorative fabric.
- The center bell and side jabots are lined in a contrasting fabric. The swag section is lined in regular drapery fabric.
- Use a felt interlining (available at most home decorative fabric stores) to give the valance the best body and shape. In addition, the color of the contrast lining fabric does not bleed through to the face when sunlight shines through the valance.
- The valance shown in the photograph is installed using corner braces for sides and a small angle iron for the center.
- The center bell and side jabots on this valance were tied with jute trim, but ribbon or chair tassels could be used.

MATERIALS

The finished width of the valance in this pattern is 40". See following chart for different window widths. These amounts are based on 54" wide fabric.

Fabrics:

- 2 ¼ yards of decorative fabric for valance front
- 1 ½ yards of contrasting fabric for lining
- 2 ¼ yards of felt interlining (to add body and shape)
- ¾ yards of drapery lining for lining of swags
- 1 ½ yards of contrasting fabric for piping and banding

Supplies

- Temporary fabric marker
- 1 – 1" Angle Iron
- 2 – 2" Corner Braces
- 3" of self-stick Velcro® hook & loop tape
- 9 yards of 4/32" Cotton Piping
- Jute Twine
- 3 Drapery Pins

YARDAGE FOR OTHER WINDOW WIDTHS

Window width	Main fabric*	Drapery Lining	Horn & Jabot Lining	Drapery interlining	Fabric for piping & banding**	4/32" cotton piping or decorative trim
Up to 42"	2 ¼ yards	¾ yards	1 ½ yards	2 ¼ yards	1 ½ yards	9 yards
43-98"	3 yards	1 ½ yards	1 ½ yards	3 yards	1 ½ yards	12 yards

*These amounts are based on 54" wide fabric. Allow extra fabric for matching patterns or repeats.

** For multiple valances, a total of 2 yards fabric for piping and banding is usually sufficient.
