

Indoor Awning Valance

GENERAL NOTES

- This valance can be adapted to fit any window width. The finished length of the valance is approximately 24" at the longest point and 20 inches at the shortest point.
- The valance works best when made from a medium-weight decorative fabric lined with a contrasting solid-color fabric.
- Use a drapery interlining (available at most home decorative stores) to give the valance the best body and shape. In addition, the color of the contrast lining fabric does not bleed through to the face when sunlight shines through the valance.
- The valance shown in the photograph is attached to the wall with decorative wooden cabinet knobs.

MATERIALS

*These quantities are for a valance for a window measuring 44" wide finished. See following chart for different window widths. **These amounts are based on 54" wide fabric.***

Fabrics:

- ¾ yards of decorative fabric* for valance front
- ¾ yards of solid color fabric (should contrast with decorative face fabric) for valance back
- ¾ yard of drapery interlining (to add body and shape)
- 1 ½ yards decorative fabric to cover piping

Supplies

- Temporary fabric maker
- 6 yards of 6/32" cotton piping or small decorative lip cord
- Grommets and grommet tool (buttonholes may be substituted)
- 4 wood resin tassels
- Hacksaw
- 5 feet of ¾" Schedule 40 PVC
- 2 ¾" x ¾" x ¾" PVC Slip T couplings (not threaded)
- 2 small wooden finials painted the color of your choice
- 1-7/8" dowel
- 2 – 1 ¼" drywall screws
- 1 ½ yards of adhesive hook and loop Velcro®
- Push pins
- 5 wooden cabinet knobs, each approximately 2 inches in diameter
- 5 dowel screws, each 3/16 x 2 inches (available at most hardware stores)

**Allow extra fabric for matching patterns and plaids*

YARDAGE FOR OTHER WINDOW WIDTHS

Window width	Face fabric*, lining & Interlining	6/32" cotton piping or decorative trim	Fabric for piping**	Tassels	Cabinet knobs, dowel screws
36"-44"	¾ yds	6 yds	1 ½ yds	4	5
45-55"	1 ½ yds	7 yds	1 ½ yds	5	6
56-66"	1 ½ yds	8 yds	1 ½ yds	6	7
67-77"	1 ½ yds	9 yds	1 ½ yds	7	8
78-88"	1 ½ yds	10 yds	1 ½ yds	8	9

**These amounts are based on 54" wide fabric. Allow extra fabric for matching patterns or repeats. ** For multiple valances, a total of 2 yards fabric for piping is usually sufficient.*
